AutoItalia Canberra is an annual display of Italian cars, motorbikes and scooters. The event has been held continuously since the early 1980s and attracts considerable interest in the ACT and from interstate.

It is not a concours event. Entry is open to any Italian car, motorbike or scooter. As such, we will get a range of vehicles from the pristine to daily drivers. The aim is to get all owners to display their Italian treasures and to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable time.

Cars are grouped by manufacturer and are then divided into coupes, convertibles and sedans. There is no pre-registration for Auto Italia. Simply bring your vehicle and you will be directed where to park, then register your car and enjoy the event.

Entrant fees are \$10 for cars and \$5 for motorbikes and scooters. Voting is undertaken by entrants only who recognize the history of the vehicles and appreciate the effort involved in their presentation.
